## *2021 Redneck Truck Race Rules & Entry*

The race will take place Friday, Aug. 6, in the grandstand-area at the Huron Community Fairgrounds. A \$40 entry fee will be collected to enter the races. Any entries turned in after mid-night Aug. 5, will be subject to an additional \$20 fee. This is to allow organizers to plan ahead for the number of drivers and keep things moving smoothly. ### **Rules are as follows:**

Trucks must be 1990 or older to be eligible for prize money. No programmable computers.

Engine must be what it would have been from the factory or something that was offered.

Vehicle must have working window net in place on the driver's side door only. Do Not weld doors shut.

If you have a diesel engine the end of the exhaust must point upward.

Mud flaps must hang within 3 inches of the ground. NO exceptions.

Must have spill proof fuel cell that is strapped in between the frame rails of the truck. Must use metal or aluminum strap at least 1-inch-wide material. No tie down straps or plumber's strapping. The fuel cell can go in the box of the truck. It just needs to be within the frame rails. Do not run any fuel through the cab of the truck.

Grain box must be secure to the frame by welding or bolting it solid.

Must have a working seat belt. A 3 or 5 -point-harness is great, but not mandatory.

Driver must wear a helmet. No exceptions.

If you are black-flagged or hauled off the track you are done for that race. No coming back onto the track if get your truck running again.

No drinking alcohol prior to or during the race.

Any questions or problems with the race are to be directed to the race director, not the help. Any swearing or arguing with the race staff will result in being disqualified and asked to leave the race immediately.

Drivers will get a 2-minute warning, if you are supposed to be in the staging area but you can't get the truck fired up. Send someone from your crew to inform the staging-hand to give you 2-minutes. The clock will count down 2-minutes, then the race will start with or without you. All drivers must be 18 years-old and possess a valid driver's license.

Drivers must put forth a \$100 cash deposit for the transponders used in the race. The money will be returned at the end of the night.

No confederate flags on any of the vehicles participating.
